Scope

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Agreement includes the following categories:

- Research collaborations in the areas of mutual interest
- Collaboration in seminars and workshops and academic meetings
- Exchange academic information (international conferences, seminars, workshops, exchange programs) and publication
- Exchange of researchers and students



Joint-supervision for graduate students

Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

- This MOA will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will email in effect for five years.
- This MOA may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partners.
- If either partner wishes to terminate the MOA at the end of five years period it must notify the other not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MOA.
- This agreement or its renewal and actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extensions to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.
